**ORDER**

**Subject: Constitution of “ Airlines Facilitation Committee”**

With the establishment and growth of several scheduled domestic airlines and consequential requirement to have an institutionalized arrangement to provide a platform for exchange of views between all Government agencies and the airlines on a regular basis, the Government has decided to constitute an “ **Airlines Facilitation committee**” comprising the following:

- (i) Joint Secretary (looking after Domestic Transport) -Chairman
  - (ii) Director General of Civil Aviation (or their senior representatives)
  - (iii) Chairman, AAI (or their senior representatives)
  - (iv) Commissioner of Security, Civil Aviation (or their senior representatives)
  - (v) Representatives of CISF
  - (vi) Representative of Indian Meteorological Department
  - (viii) Representatives of the Domestic Scheduled Airlines.
2. The Committee shall deliberate and suggest measures to be taken by the Government on-
- (i) Issues pertaining to pilots, engineers, technicians etc. including the issues of engaging foreign pilots.
  - (ii) Airworthiness examination of aircraft.
  - (iii) Airport issues including security issues.
  - (iv) Preparation of airlines for landing during fog period
  - (v) North East Operations and issues pertaining to Route Dispersal Guidelines.
  - (vi) Rationalization of schedules
  - (vii) International Conventions and Protocol
  - (viii) Redressal of passenger complaints
  - (ix) Any other relevant issue
