Subject: **Constitution of Task Force to discuss various issues affecting airlines**

With the rapid growth of both airlines and airports there is a requirement to have an institutional arrangement to provide a platform to resolve the issues affecting airlines and airports. The Government has, therefore, decided to constitute a Task Force comprising the following:

- (i) The Director General of Civil Aviation - Chairman
- (ii) Joint Secretary (Airport Division)
- (iii) Chairman, Airports Authority of India
- (iv) Addl. Commissioner, BCAS nominated by COS (CA)
- (v) Representative of Federation of Indian Airlines
- (vi) Three representatives of Airline Operators (NACIL, Jet Airways and IndiGo).
- (vii) Representative of Private Airport Operators –DIAL & MIAL.

The Task Force can co-opt representative of any organization/operator for a specific task.

2. The scope of this Task Force will be to resolve short term operational issues affecting airlines and airports. It would also identify the various avenues for optimal utilization of space at Airports as well issues relating to proper utilization of flight slots by airlines.

3. The task force would meet regularly once a month and submit a quarterly report to the Government. The task force would be serviced by office of DGCA.

4. This issues with the approval of Secretary, M/o Civil Aviation.
